797. Hon BEN DAWKINS to the minister representing the Minister for Housing:

I refer the minister to my question without notice C856.

- (1) Did the department of housing ask or represent to the Water Corporation to amend the greater Bunbury region scheme to reduce the odour buffer in Dalyellup?
- (2) Did the department ask or represent to the Water Corporation to further reduce the odour buffer from what is shown in figure 18 of the Water Corporation's odour modelling study?
- (3) Can the minister table the joint venture agreement between the department and the Satterley Property Group relating to the Greenpatch development; and, if not, why not?

Hon JACKIE JARVIS replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. The following response has been provided by the Minister for Housing.

(1)–(3) Buffer requirements are guided by State Planning Policy 4.1—Industrial Interface and do not form part of joint venture agreements. The buffer was established in 2013 through scheme amendment 0020/57 to the greater Bunbury regional scheme. Landowners and relevant government agencies were consulted as part of the scheme amendment process.
