1701. Hon Ljiljanna Ravlich to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Attorney General

Of the 2 838 complaints and notifications that were assessed by the Corruption and Crime Commission in 2008-09 —

- (1) How many involved public sector Agencies and which ones?
- (2) How many involved public servants?
- (3) From which Agencies were they employed?

Hon MICHAEL MISCHIN replied:

- (1) The 2,838 complaints and notifications received involved 3,205 allegations. The 3,205 allegations dealt with by the Commission were broken down as follows:
  - State public sector agencies — 2,890 (90%)
  - Local government shires and councils — 285 (9%)
  - Not within CCC jurisdiction — 30 (1%)
