## CORRUPTION AND CRIME COMMISSION — SCOTT DOUGLAS AUSTIC

922. Hon Nick Goiran to the parliamentary secretary representing the Attorney General:

I refer to the ABC article "Scott Austic was acquitted of murdering Stacey Thorne after evidence of crime scene tampering. Now both their families seek answers" from 4 April 2022, and I ask:

- (a) are you aware that the Corruption and Crime Commission told Australian Story earlier this year that it was "reviewing the Court of Appeal findings relating to police conduct";
- (b) when did this review commence;
- (c) noting the strength of the damning findings against police and that the length of time the Corruption and Crime Commission has had to conduct its review, has it been completed;
- (d) if no to, when is it expected to be completed; and
- (e) on how many occasions during this review has the Attorney General personally received an update from the Corruption and Crime Commission Commissioner about the progress of this matter?

## **Hon Matthew Swinbourn replied:**

- (a) Yes.
- (b) 28 July 2021.
- (c) No.
- (d) The Commission is unable to provide an expected completion date.
- (e) The Commission has not updated the Attorney General on the progress of this matter.
