“ Legislative Council.”*

Accordingly Mr. Speaker, with members of the House, went to attend His Excellency the Governor, when His Excellency was pleased to give the Royal Assent to a number of Bills; and delivered a Speech [*vide page 1177 ante*] proroguing Parliament till Wednesday, the 28th March, 1894.
