

## DAYLIGHT SAVING AMENDMENT BILL 2007 (E 192)

### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

*(Introduced by Mr Brendon Grylls)*

#### Part 1 – Preliminary

- Clause 1     Short title**  
Provides for the Act to be cited as the *Daylight Saving Amendment Act 2007*.
- Clause 2     Commencement**  
This clause provides for the Act to come into operation on the day on which it receives Royal Assent.

#### Part 2 – Amendments to the *Daylight Saving Act 2006*

- Clause 3     The Act amended**  
This clause provides that the amendments in this Act are to the *Daylight Saving Act 2006*.
- Clause 4     Section 4 amended**  
This clause amends section 4 of the *Daylight Saving Act 2006* to delete reference to trial periods of daylight saving for the summers of 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09.
- Clause 5     Section 5 amended**  
This clause amends section 5 of the *Daylight Saving Act 2006* to delete reference to a referendum planned for between 10 May 2009 and 13 September 2009, bringing the date of said referendum forward to 20 October 2007.

The prescribed referendum question is subsequently changed to ask whether daylight saving should be introduced each summer, starting from the last Sunday in October 2007.
