Division 1 — *Constitution Act 1889* amended

15. Act amended

This Division amends the *Constitution Act 1889*.

16. Section 75A inserted

After section 74 insert:

75A. Demise of the Sovereign

- (1) The demise of the Sovereign does not affect the continuation of the Parliament of Western Australia and does not give rise to or necessitate the prorogation or dissolution of either House.
- (2) The demise of the Sovereign does not affect the existence and use of the Public Seal of the State.
- (3) The demise of the Sovereign does not discontinue or affect —
 - (a) any civil, criminal or other proceeding in any court or tribunal; or

- (b) any civil, criminal or other proceeding to which the Crown is a party or which has been commenced or carried on in the name of or with the authority of the Crown.

Division 2 — Other provisions

17. Certain enactments passed before 1 June 1829 repealed

So far as any Imperial Act enacted before 1 June 1829 —

- (a) is part of the law of this State; and
- (b) purports to deal with or relate to the effect or consequences of the demise of the Sovereign,

it is repealed.
