Questions listed for this sitting: -

3189. Mr F.M. Logan to the Minister for Training and Workforce Development:

I draw the Minister's attention to the *Stratton Review of the Operation and Effectiveness of the Building and Construction Industry Training Fund and Levy Collection Act* (the Review), and I ask:

- (a) the Review made a number of recommendations, when will the Government provide a timeline on its response and plan for the recommendations in the report and if not, why not;
- (b) the 7th dot point of the recommendations calls for the "withdrawal of the current exemption applying to engineering construction projects in the resources sector and consider applying a tiered levy based on project value," will you support this suggestion and if not, why not; and
- (c) Western Australia has the worst ratio of apprentices to trades people in construction in Australia (according to the *National Centre for Vocational Education Research Report 2014a*; table 12); given this statistic, please explain to the House and the Broader community, why the government has failed to act on the recommendations contained in the Review?

3190. Mr F.M. Logan to the Minister for Housing:

I draw the Minister's attention to the Department development of the former East Greenwood Primary School site in conjunction with the company Australand, and I ask:

- (a) how many apartments/units of accommodation will be built on this site;
- (b) assuming that the Department of Housing is the client for the development of the site, how will the apartments/units of accommodation be used? For example:
 - (i) how many apartments/units of accommodation will be sold;
 - (ii) how many apartments/units of accommodation will be available through shared equity or similar programs;
 - (iii) how many apartments/units of accommodation will be given or made available to Community Housing providers; and
 - (iv) how many apartments/units of accommodation will be made available for Homewest accommodation;
- (c) if the final ownership structure of apartments/units of accommodation are different to that set out in (b), please provide a breakdown of sale, lease or both;
- (d) what is total estimated cost of the East Greenwood Primary School site project; and
- (e) what is the estimated build cost for the project?
