## FIRST SESSION OF THE THIRTY-EIGHTH PARLIAMENT

# **WEDNESDAY, 11 MARCH 2009**

### 1. Meeting of Assembly

The Assembly met at 12.00 noon pursuant to adjournment.

The Speaker took the Chair.

Prayers were read.

## 2. Speaker's Statement - Joint Sitting to fill a Vacancy in the Senate

The Speaker advised members that a joint sitting of both Houses was held this day and that Dr Christopher John Back was duly elected as a Senator of the Commonwealth Parliament.

### 3. Economics and Industry Standing Committee - Terms of Reference

The Speaker advised members that he had received a letter dated 10 March 2009 from the Chairman of the Economics and Industry Standing Committee, advising that the Committee had resolved to conduct an inquiry into the Provision, Use and Regulation of Caravan Parks (and Camping Grounds) in Western Australia.

In particular, the Committee will investigate the:

- (1) Structure, conduct and performance of the caravan park industry;
- (2) Demand, supply and costs, and trends thereof, of caravan park sites and related services;
- (3) Supply and demand for long- and short-stay sites including camping sites;
- (4) Impact of existing legislation, and state and local government policies regulating caravan parks, particularly relating to:
  - (a) maintaining a viable caravan park industry;
  - (b) protecting the rights of operators and users; and
  - (c) providing an adequate mix of long- and short-stay facilities and sites.

The Committee will report to the Assembly on 24 September 2009.

The Speaker advised members that he had arranged for the Committee's terms of reference to be placed on the notice boards of the Legislative Assembly.

#### 4. Petition

Herald Avenue Senior Citizens' Centre - Mr W.J. Johnston presented a petition from 122 persons requesting that the former 155 bus route be reinstated to allow residents of the Lynwood, Ferndale, and Langford areas to travel to the Herald Avenue Senior Citizens' Centre in Willetton (P. 48).
