### 3. Statement by President — The Key to Your House

The President made the following Statement —

This is a reminder that *The Key to Your House*, the 12-part documentary exploring the history, roles and functions of the Western Australia Parliament, will commence broadcasting tonight at 5.45 pm on West Television, channel 44. Channel 44 is available on the in-house MATV system.

The program, which has taken six months to produce, is very raw and honest and will answer a lot of questions the community has about Parliament. A significant number of Members, former Members and staff have contributed to the documentary, and I thank them for their effort. Through interviews they share not only their professional journeys to this place, but also some very personal stories, revealing a human side to Parliament. In some ways the program is a social commentary on the changing times in the State of Western Australia. The history behind the staged construction of Parliament House, women's entry into politics, the Parliament art collection and Parliament's legislative program are windows into the state's social and economic past. Through historical reflection, however, the centrality of Parliament to community life also becomes very evident.

Members of the public see question time but rarely do they get to see other parliamentary processes. As a result, they do not always understand the opportunities available to them to influence parliamentary decision-making. This program brings clarity to those processes and shows how, historically, the community has influenced government outcomes on issues about which they are passionate. The documentary is both interesting and entertaining and contains interviews and current and historical footage and images. Although it explains the processes and dignities of Parliament, it also tells some of our quirky stories. I strongly encourage Members to promote the documentary among their staff and constituents.
