Question C1 . Hon Paul Brown.

When is the Wheatbelt Safety Review going to take place, when is it expected to be completed and when will we find some detail about it?

Answer:

- An examination of crash data during the first half of the year identified the Great Eastern Highway and Chidlow-York Road (Great Southern Hwy) as having an above average crash rate, together with Toodyay Road which was already subject to a review by Main Roads WA.
- A community forum in Merredin and technical analysis of the routes was held on 6-7 August 2015 following a period of online community engagement.
- A community forum in Toodyay is being organised for 9 November 2015.
- A report on the Review and its recommendations will be presented to the Minister for Road Safety in the near future.
