

**STANDING COMMITTEE ON ESTIMATES AND FINANCIAL OPERATIONS**

**ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS PRIOR TO HEARING**

Office of the Parliamentary Inspector of the Corruption and Crime Commission

Hon Nick Goiran MLC asked:

1. I refer to page 504, Budget No. 2, Volume 2, and I ask:

- (a) How much of the Total Appropriations was allocated towards investigating complaints regarding the CCC's handling of allegations of police misconduct; and
- (b) How many complaints regarding the CCC's handling of allegations of police misconduct were made to the PICCC in 2020-21?

1. The answers are:

- (a) The office of the Parliamentary Inspector does not specifically allocate funds towards the investigation of particular classes of complaints regarding the Corruption and Crime Commission. However, it is estimated that 62% of the office's resources will be devoted to investigations/complaints during the 2021-2022 financial year.

During the 2020-2021 financial year, 45% of the complaints received by the office related to the Commission's handling of allegations of police misconduct, and it is anticipated that this proportion will be similar during the 2021-2022 financial year.

- (b) 44 of the 98 complaints made to the office of the Parliamentary Inspector during 2020-2021 related at least in part to the Commission's handling of allegations of police misconduct.
