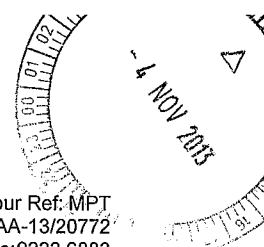

I wish to advise that in my evidence given to the Committee at the public hearing held on Monday 28 October 2013, the transcript requires several corrections. These are as follows:

1. Page 2, paragraph 4: the sentence "In part 4, the bill allows for persons to sell, supply or use a person when inappropriately licenced", should read "appropriately licenced".
2. Page 3, paragraph 5: the sentence "In addition, much of the specific TG expertise", should read "TGA expertise".
3. Page 8, paragraph 1: the sentence that reads "there should not be a lower standard for an Australian or someone operating in Australia", was intended to be spoken as "there should not be a lower standard for a West Australian or someone operating in Western Australia".
4. Page 11, paragraph 12: the sentence that reads "I am just trying to think – my pencil answer would be yes", should read "my personal answer".
5. Page 12, paragraph 1: the sentence "If you imported products of that nature and then started selling them onwards, that is a difficult situation", should read "different situation".
