The inquiry into end of life choices

As previously announced, a Parliamentary committee is conducting an inquiry into the need for laws in Western Australia to allow citizens to make informed decisions regarding their own end of life choices.

The Committee is very pleased with the response from the public to its call for submissions.

The Committee Chair, Ms Amber-Jade Sanderson MLA stated:

The Committee has now accepted more than 680 submissions received in response to its invitation to the public.

I want to thank all those who have taken the time to make a submission.

Submissions range from individuals sharing their deeply personal and powerful stories, advocacy organisations, government agencies, religious institutions, professional associations, academics and a range of others.

Many of the submissions are already available on the Committee's website and more will become available as the Committee has an opportunity to process these.

This is a topic that affects us all and I would encourage people to read the submissions for themselves.

The Committee is now moving to the next stage of its inquiry process and will be conducting a series of public hearings on Wednesday, 13 December 2017 and Thursday, 14 December 2017, commencing each day at 11:00 am. More hearings, including some conducted in regional areas, are expected to be held next year.

The Committee will be taking evidence from representatives of various areas within the Department of Health, relevant professional associations and not for profit service providers, as follows:
