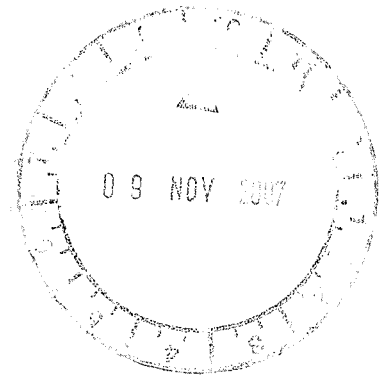
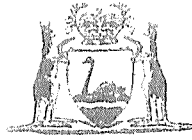
To that end, I attach a copy of correspondence to Mr Winzer inviting him to make application to his employer for a voluntary severance payment.
