## COMMITTEE REPORTS: GOVERNMENT RESPONSE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STANDING ORDER 337

Thank you for providing a copy of the Joint Standing Committee On Delegated Legislation's Report No. 35 - Fish Resources Management Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2009 ("the Report").

The Report has been referred to the Department of Fisheries (the Department) and a Funding Working Group, which is supported by the Department so the Committee's findings and recommendations may be taken into account when developing a new fee-setting model for fisheries in Western Australia. I expect that the model will be in place before 30 June 2010 for all fees made under the Fish Resources Management Act 1994 and the Pearling Act 1990.

In the meantime, I will not be approving any further fees that have a Development and Better Interest Fund component.

As you would be aware, new fees for the fisheries the subject of *Report No. 35* would normally be gazetted in January or February each year. Given the findings and recommendations of the Report, changes to these fees will now be deferred until early 2011 when a new fee structure is in place.
