Dear Mr Speaker

It has been brought to the Committee's attention that there was an error of fact in the Committee's most recent report, *Are we there yet? How WA Police determines whether traffic law enforcement is effective* (Report No.8).

On page 61 (paragraph 3), our report incorrectly cites a report published by the Curtin-Monash Accident Research Centre<sup>1</sup>, stating that:

"...nearly two-thirds of WA road fatalities during the period 2008-2012 tested positive to illicit drugs, with cannabis the most prevalent drug detected by WA Police..."

We note that the correct statement is:

"... 22.7 per cent of drivers/riders fatally injured during the period 2000-2012 tested positive to illicit drugs, with cannabis the most prevalent drug detected by ChemCentre analysis..."

Additionally, on page 62, we note that the footnote 226 reference should be:

Road Safety Council, *Report on Activities 2013-14*. Government of Western Australia, Perth, 2014, pp16-17.

We intend to publish this erratum on the Committee's website.
