## Inquiry into Co-operatives Amendment Bill 2015

I refer to your invitation to provide a written submission on whether the clauses of the Co-operatives Amendment Bill 2015 (the "Bill") may impact upon the sovereignty and law making powers of the Parliament of Western Australia.

To the best of our belief and understanding the Bill does not impact upon the sovereignty and law making powers of the Parliament of Western Australia.

The Bill proposes amendments to the Co-operatives Act 2009 to achieve consistency with the Co-operatives National Law and to allow Western Australian co-operatives to participate in a national regulatory Scheme for the registration and regulation of co-operatives. As the state peak industry body for co-operatives in Western Australia, with a voluntary membership of 40 co-operative enterprises of the 52 registered co-operatives in WA, we have been a long-time supporter of the simplification process.

We are continuing our detailed review of the Bill, now it is in the public domain, and whilst not expecting to encounter any issues we are waiting to see the supporting Regulations, to confirm they reflect the wishes of the WA sector as advanced through the Industry Reference Group, of which Co-operatives WA was a leading member.
