Approximately six months ago I launched an online petition with regards to getting a better licencing

Scheme for Classic and Modified Vehicles. (\$90 for 90 days Rego for Classic & Modified cars) To date over 5800 people have signed/endorsed this proposal to the Department of Transport and the State government.

Currently in W A, if a vintage or classic car is modified it is very difficult to get it registered and you have to pay full registration fees.

South Australia has reduced the RED TAPE by introducing a \$90 fee for 90 days unrestricted road use. Similar schemes operate in Victoria and New South Wales.

Many classic cars were sitting idle in sheds because their owners didn't want to pay hundreds of dollars for full registration.

These changes mean that car enthusiasts can make modifications to their vehicles without forcing them off the road and into the garage.

This will have a flow on effect to automotive businesses such as panel beaters, painters, motor trimmers & mechanics as owners prepare to put their cars back on the road.

Despite these changes, vehicles with major modifications such as engine upgrades will still be required to undergo safety inspections and obtain relevant approvals to gain registration.

I therefore would like to present this petition to The Select Committee of Personal Choice and Community safety.
