

Having a special needs child has proven difficult for him to attend our local public school due to lack of funding to supply the one on one support he needs for safety and learning. This meant him attending a school which is 20kms away from our home and that he and his sister attend separate schools which was heart breaking for them.both. I managed to enrol my daughter into the school my son attends which is great but now being a single mum and travelling 80km and sometimes more a day is financially straining and limiting. There is no assistance for transport for us. To have a bus dedicated to schools between dawesville and meadow springs (for multiple primary schools) would benefit alot of us in the local communities. Having a 9 yr old and 6 yr old (ASD) they are way to young to catch public transport so no other option.
