We've received a decline letter for the school bus as the Christian school that my children attend isn't far enough away. We recently moved to Burekup and hit this hurdle, as the kids are unable to walk or ride to school due to having to travel on 100km hwy, cross two sets of railways and navigate across Colefields hey. This is an absolute joke that they expect children to be able to do this. I articulated all of this in a letter to simply just be declined and that's it. For the past 8yrs they have had a orange school bus service Burekup to only recently stop servicing Burekup from Hope Christian College. They basically said if the kids changed schools they could get a bus to Bunbury senior high school if seats were available. My kids have been at Hope for 4yrs so I didn't even want that as an option. All I want as well as many other parents in the area is for our children to be able to get to and from school safely. I work as a nurse so my hours aren't school friendly so I've had to cut my hours right back so that I can drop off and pick up. Please can we get a bus for Hope Christian from Burekup please, all they need to do is come and have a look at what we face daily and ask themselves if they would let their children/grandchildren walk to school with all dangers.
