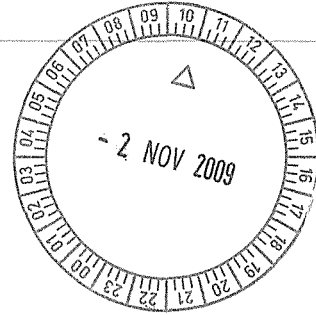

Subject: recreation access to drinking water catchments



Good Morning,

This is just a short note to urge all members to remove the access restrictions for recreational use of our drinking water catchments in the south west of the state.

As a keen recreational angler who has had the opportunity to fish on some of the NSW and QLD stocked impoundments, I know exactly what the rec. angling public is missing out on here in WA.

I believe that both drinking water requirements and recreational needs can be managed, as they are in other states, simultaneously so all parties can achieve satisfactory outcomes.

I also ask that if rec angling access is granted that native species such as Australian Bass and Murray Cod are considered for stocking before any trout species.
