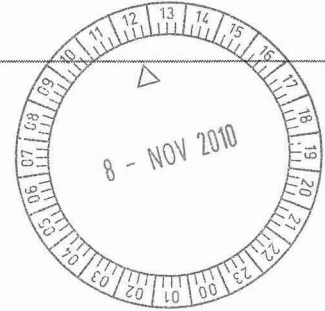

Impact of Cockburn Cement Ltd Emission on inhabitants.

1. Son with asthma has been forced to move out. Any time he returns he experiences continual problems with breathing within hours of being at the property.
2. The horses are affected by emission. Nasal discharges are common and when working the animals they are not getting enough "Clean Air" to allow efficient breathing.
- 3 This has reduces our opportunities to develop and train horses to be competitive and productive.
4. All who stay here now show increased nasal irritation by continually blowing noses and clearing throats more than would be considered normal.

The plans by the company to address these emissions is very, very slow response and we feel that in the interest of health it need to be implemented more quickly than currently planned.

Ideally to move the company would be ideal.
