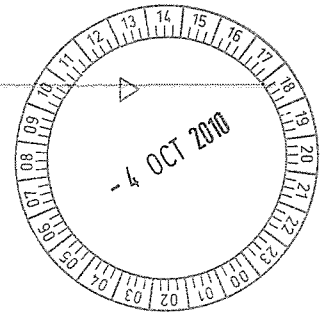

Hello

On the weekend of 2nd/3rd October, the burning odours from Cockburn Cement were distressing. From my house on _____, Saturday there were incidences of burning odour I recognised from our backyard in the late morning. My partner and family suffered through 3-5 episodes of burning odour whilst in our backyard Sunday from 10am, of total duration of atleast 30 minutes of very bad odour, and then time of reduced but still noticeable odour. They were so frequent, it really felt like they were continuous with a small reprieve of fresh air in between. At the time, it leaves your throat dry and eventually with a headache because you find yourself taking shallow breaths from naturally trying to avoid breathing in too much of the odour.

I don't understand what is going on at the plant that the odour is occurring so frequently. When we first bought our land, odour was not the issue it is now. It's going to drive me from my home I love. We're considering making a loss to move now (if there's anyone that will buy the place!) or waiting it out another 2-5 years so that we don't make a loss on the house, but in a way I'm wishing, praying Cockburn Cement may fix their odour issues in that time so we don't have to leave.

I'm hoping that this email will at least remind you that we are suffering, and that the actions taking place are not having any benefit so far. Can you please advise what is the status of the situation of Cockburn Cement such as what is taking place or will take place to resolve the odour issues?
