His issue is that Eventscorp/One Movement promised patronage and audience verbally to a certain level (not in writing) and did not deliver.

My argument is that the "economic benefits analysis" undertaken by Eventscorp does not factor in losses that West Australians make from being involved in the event.

If stallholders had been made aware of the audit advice that One Movement Pty Ltd was not a "going concern" and not in compliance with the Corporations Act, they may have been able to make an informed decision about participating. Eventscorp had a duty to WA businesses to ensure they were fully informed.

Troy has said he'd be happy to talk to the committee if you were going to look at this avenue.

Also, I spoke to WAMI CEO Paul Bodlovich. He said to me that while WAMI had not put in a written submission to the Committee, he expected that he would be called to give evidence.
