

**PETITION IN RELATION TO

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of Western Australia are opposed to changes to the Local Government Act 1995 that reduce electors rights to decide on boundary changes and amalgamations.
