

## **PETITION IN RELATION TO MENDES STREET TRADERS AND SOUTH PERTH COUNCIL**

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of Western Australia are opposed to the treatment of many small business owners by the City of South Perth who have allowed multiple developments and works to be undertaken around the Mendis Street shopping precinct. These works have been approved by Council without consideration given to the negative impacts they will have on already established businesses, as they failed to undertake or consider any financial impact study/modelling prior to approval.
