To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of the City of Swan respectfully advise Honourable Members that:

- Southern Cross Care (WA) Incorporated submitted to the City of Swan a Master Plan for the development of Lot 501 Paradise Quays Ballajura on the Emu Swamp Reserve, land owned by the City of Swan and upon which any development is subject to approval under the Aboriginal Heritage Act of 1972.
- Without pubic consultation, Council approved the Master Plan on 12 December 2018.
- On 16 January 2019 Council received a petition signed by 183 persons to this effect: "We the residents of the Lakes Estate request that the City of Swan put aside the Council decision of the 12<sup>th</sup> December to enable a proper consultation process, negotiated with the residents of the Lakes Estate."
- The City of Swan as the owner of land has a conflict of interest in unilaterally approving development on that land.

And we the undersigned respectfully ask Honourable Members to persuade the City of Swan to engage in full public consultation and to seek the advice of the Minister for Local Government before allowing the development to proceed.
