NO URBAN DEVELOPMENT SOUTH OF THE MOORE RIVER

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of
Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned residents of Western Australia, are opposed to any
development south of the Moore River, a view which has been consistently and
strongly put forward by the community since 1995.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully request the Legislative Council to
recommend that the land adjoining the proposed Wilbinga Conservation
Park which is subject to Moore River Company's plans, **be purchased by the
Government at a fair price to the landowner, be managed in perpetuity for
the benefit of the whole community, for the protection of the estuary of the
Moore River, and serving as a buffer zone against further metropolitan
encroachment.**

We make this request because of the unique aesthetic and environmental
features which this area contributes towards the natural capital of Western
Australia.
