PETITION TO END THE GREAT WHITE SHARK CULL

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, are gravely concerned by the Government of Western Australia's (Minister for Fisheries') plan to pre-emptively kill Great White Sharks in WA under its shark mitigation strategy.

Great White Sharks (*Carcharodon carcharias*) are listed as a 'totally protected fish' in WA under the *Fish Resources Management (FRMA) Act 1994*, 'Vulnerable' under the federal *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation (EPBC) Act 1999* and is internationally listed on the *Convention of International Trade in Endangered Species of wild fauna and flora (CITES)* and the *Convention on Migratory Species (CMS)*, because of the significant and ongoing population declines reported in literature and unpublished data¹.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully request the Legislative Council strongly recommend that the plan to pre-emptively kill Great White Sharks to be withdrawn and for Parliament and inquire into science-based approaches to managing shark-human interactions, recognising the serious threats shark species face in WA and around the world. And your petitioners as in duty bound, will ever pray.
