# **PETITION FOR BETTER RAIL AND BUS SERVICES between Mandurah, Fremantle, Armadale and Perth**

To the Honourable the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned residents of Western Australia, call on the Legislative Council to request the Minister for Transport to improve public transport services in the Southern Corridor of Metropolitan Perth by :

- 1. Increasing the numbers of carriages and train services during rush hours by 2014.**
- 2. Constructing light rail networks connecting activity centres and stations in the areas of Mandurah, Armadale, Rockingham, Kwinana, Cockburn, Murdoch and Fremantle.**
- 3. Providing adequate linking bus services that will give commuters viable options to taking private cars.**
- 4. Constructing a train link to the Perth Airport as a priority.**
- 5. Funding these measures from Main Roads budgets.**

Our petitioners therefore respectfully request that the Legislative Council recommend that the Minister for Transport take the above measures to improve the efficiency and sustainability of public transport. And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
