PETITION IN RELATION TO AN INQUIRY INTO RECYCLING AND COMPOSTING IN WA

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of Western Australia want an improvement in the low recycling rates for WA and the lack of recycling and composting infrastructure which undermines the principles of ecological and economic sustainability in WA.
