Thank you for your letter dated 5 December 2018 in relation to Petition No. 095 to the International School of Western Australia.

The City did not have a decision making role in respect to the Development Assessment Panel (DAP) applications for the Replacement Educational Establishment (Doubleview Primary School) (DA16/1900 refers) or the Proposed Educational Establishment (International School of Western Australia) (DA17/1718 refers).

The Metro North-West Joint Development Assessment Panel (JDAP) was the determining authority for these DAP applications. The Proposed Replacement Educational Establishment (Doubleview Primary School) (DA16/1900 refers) was approved by the Metro North-West JDAP on 31 July 2017 and the Proposed Educational Establishment (International School of Western Australia) (DA17/1718 refers) was approved by the Metro North-West JDAP on 22 February 2018. A copy of the JDAP approvals are attached for your information.

On 23 February 2017, the City received two petitions which relate to the Development Assessment Panel application for the Proposed Replacement Educational Establishment (Doubleview Primary School) (DA16/1900 refers) at Lot 7932, Doubleview Primary School, HN 193 St Brigids Terrace, Doubleview. 
