**PETITION IN RELATION TO PROPOSED BOATING FACILITIES AND CARPARK AT ENTRANCE POINT, BROOME**

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned are opposed to the destruction of the beach and reefs at Entrance Point for small boat launching and carpark facilities. The beach and reef are highly valued and important to local families for gatherings, contemplation, wellbeing and heritage and has been for millennia. One hundred and thirty million-year-old dinosaur footprints of global significance would also be destroyed by the proposal.

We therefore ask the Legislative Council to recommend that the State Government not fund this proposal and seek alternative measures to enhance safety such as education on how to launch and retrieve boats in Broome.
