PETITION RELATING TO 22 KENTIA LOOP, WANNEROO, 6065

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, respectfully express our disagreement with the purchase of the house at 22 Kentia Loop, Timberlands Estate, Wanneroo, by the Department for Child Protection for use as an interim Care Centre for abused juveniles. We have major concerns for our safety and the safety of our families, as well as for our properties, should this particular project proceed, especially as most of us have grandchildren visiting and staying with us during school holidays.

Many residents of Timberlands Estate are people with special needs who cannot live with locked doors (in case of emergencies) and who do not need extra security problems to worry about. We believe the State Government has a duty of care for our community and must act in our best interests in this matter.

Your petitioners humbly request that the Legislative Council asks the Minister for Child Protection to review this decision with a view to purchasing another property in a more suitable location, thus protecting our security and amenity.

And your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
