**PETITION IN RELATION TO PROPOSED REALIGNMENT OF THE SOUTHWEST FREIGHT RAIL  
LINE**

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in  
Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned are opposed to the altered freight rail line realignment south of Mundijong  
Road as proposed by the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale in its Mundijong District Structure Plan  
2020. This new route drastically alters the freight line realignment from previous published  
designs without prior consultation with the impacted landowners and residents. Existing  
landowners purchased their properties on the basis of the Shire's district structure plan that was  
current at the time of their purchase. The route proposed in these plans were consistent between  
the years of 2008 to 2018.

The new proposed route from Mundijong Road to Wright Road will now impact newly built  
homes and has already had an adverse impact on the properties values and saleability. The  
impacted properties are blighted by the proposed route. The affected landowners have no  
security and face an uncertain future until such time as the matter is resolved. For many affected  
landowners, time is of the essence in seeking a mutually acceptable resolution.

We therefore ask the Legislative Council to recommend that the Department of Transport, Main  
Roads and Arc Infrastructure work with the Shire of Serpentine Jarrahdale to investigate options  
that will see the rail delivered as per the previous realignment.
