PETITION IN RELATION TO THE FUNDING OF FIRST CLICK AND SECOND CLICK PROGRAMS

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned residents of Western Australia, are opposed to the Barnett Government's decision to cut funding to the First Click and Second Click programs that teach participants essential computer skills.

The First Click and Second Click programs were established by the Labor Government in 2001 to provide learning resources and grants to not-for-profit, community organisations to deliver computer literacy lessons.

Despite Premier Barnett's comments that there is no longer a need, the program continues to be necessary as it offers valuable benefits to a wide group of students, including people from regional areas, seniors, women aged 40 to 54 not in employment, youth, people with disabilities, Indigenous people, people for whom English is not their first language and people on low incomes.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully request the Legislative Council to take full and comprehensive action to ensure the reinstatement of funding for the First Click and Second Click programs.
