thank you for your letter of the 15th October providing me an opportunity for a submission on my petition.

My point is very simple so I will not need two pages.

SAFETY; Boorara road is used by milk tankers, log trucks, grain trucks, cattle trucks, all semi's and the road is also used by the public, including the school bus.

The bridge over the Gardner river, just south of the townsite, is approached from both sides on a steep decline.

Since the bridge was declared unsafe because of weight loading, they have made it a single lane bridge, requiring one side to give way.

A real dangerous situation.

I was verbally informed by Main roads that this said bridge wasnt on their 3 year future plan for replacement.

I respectfully request you consider bringing this project forward.

I have not taken this issue to the Ombudsman
