Petition No 136 - Kwinana Air Quality Buffer Zone Extension (Mandogalup)

I am writing to you with regards to your letter dated 26 Sep 2012 seeking an update on the current situation with respect to our concerns.

Since the tabling of our petition, none of the local residents in the Mandogalup and Wattleup areas have received any additional information or communication from any government agencies, departments and ALCOA with regards to the extended buffer. The petitioners are very disappointed with the lack of any clarifications on the impact of the extended buffer.

There as been no progress in the claims we seek in our petition.

We feel that it is necessary that government agencies such as Department of Planning and Department of Health to promptly notify the local residents about the planning and health impact of the extended buffer so the petitioners can plan for the future.

The Department of Health has conducted ground water quality testing at the request of a local resident at the end of 2011 and the Department has not provided any results so far.

We ask the Committee to investigate and enquire about these issues further.
