PETITION IN RELATION TO ABORIGINAL HERITAGE SITES

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled. We the undersigned petitioners, residents of Australia, respectfully request the Legislative Council to support the following actions:

- Re-register the Burrup Peninsula [Murujuga], the world's oldest and largest rock art landscape, and the other sites recently deregistered by the Western Australian government on flawed legal advice.
• Abandon the proposed Aboriginal Heritage Act Amendment Bill 2014, which would make it easier to destroy or damage places of significance to Aboriginal people throughout Western Australia.
• In consultation with Aboriginal people, establish an inquiry to review the Aboriginal Heritage Act 1972, the operations of WA's Department of Aboriginal Affairs, and the Aboriginal Cultural Materials Committee, to ensure ongoing protection of Aboriginal places of spiritual and cultural significance.
