PETITION IN RELATION TO THE CLOSURE OF ACTIV BUSINESS SERVICE CENTRE IN  
BUSSELTON

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned residents of Western Australia are opposed the closure of the ACTIV Business Service Centre in Busselton (ACTIV Busselton).

Your petitioners therefore respectfully request the Legislative Council to recommend to the State Government that it:

- work with the ACTIV Foundation to ensure the ACTIV Busselton remains open;
- instruct all Government Department and Agencies with offices in the Capes regions identify jobs and tasks that can be contracted out to ACTIV Busselton and to enter into contacts with ACTIV Busselton for delivery of those services; and
- write to the Federal Government calling on the Federal Government to work with ACTIV Foundation to ensure ACTIV Busselton remains open, including an examination of the ACTIV Foundation financial records and a review of the level of funding provided by the Federal Government to ACTIV Foundation, AND in the event that ACTIV Busselton must close, to ensure that the ACTIV Foundation:
  - o does not require its Busselton employees with disabilities to pay their mobility allowance to the ACTIV Foundation towards the cost of transporting them to and from ACTIV Bunbury for work; and
  - o respects the rights of ACTIV Busselton supervisory staff (employees without disabilities), including option to transfer to ACTIV Bunbury or voluntary redundancy with full payment of wages owing, holiday pay, superannuation, redundancy payment and all other benefits to which they are entitled.

And your petitioners as in duty bound, will ever pray.
