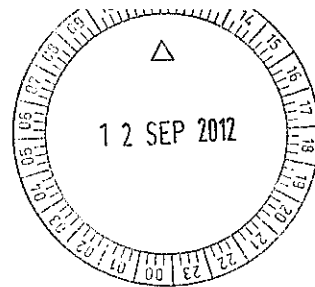

PETITION NO 158 – SHIRE OF KALAMUNDA LOCAL PLANNING SCHEME 3

I refer to your letter dated 22 August 2012 regarding an amendment to the above Town Planning Scheme and seeking information on the nature of the documentation provided to the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) by the Shire of Kalamunda and whether that impacted on the EPA's decision to assess the Amendment.

The Shire of Kalamunda referred Amendment 18 to the EPA in June 2009. The documentation provided was a copy of the Shire of Kalamunda Planning Services Committee Agenda - 11 May 2009 agenda item 43, appendices for item 43 and report titled Scheme Amendment Documents.

The EPA's decision to 'Not Assess' Amendment 18 was based on the EPA's understanding, as stated in the Shire's documentation, that the development proposed on the rezoned land was able to be serviced by reticulated sewerage.
