**PETITION IN RELATION TO THE MIDLAND RAILWAY WORKSHOPS**

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia  
in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned call upon the State Government to create a Railway Museum on the  
grounds of the Midland Railway Workshops site, which should include the reopening of the  
Railway Interpretive Centre. We are of the view that the current plans surrounding the Midland  
site are a mere token gesture, which we believe does not truly reflect the historical significance  
of the Railway Workshops in Western Australia.

We regard the workshops as a highly significant part of the history of this state, with which many  
West Australians have a direct link.

We therefore ask the Legislative Council to recommend and support the  
construction/conversion of the Midland Railway Workshops site into a railway heritage museum,  
and seek the reopening of the Railway Interpretive Centre.
