PETITION No. 131 – CEMENT AND LIME MANUFACTURING, NOWERGUP

I refer to your letter of 28 March 2012 regarding the above matter and in particular the reference to State Planning Policy 2.4 Basic Raw Materials (SPP 2.4).

SPP 2.4 is a Western Australian Planning Commission (WAPC) policy gazetted on 28 July 2000. Any processes associated with the designation of land as a priority resource area under the policy are the responsibility of the WAPC. Accordingly, I would recommend that questions of process in relation to both public consultation and environmental assessment are more appropriately directed to the WAPC.
