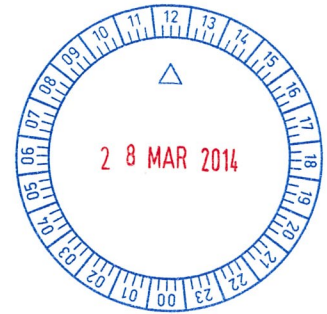

Dear Simon,

Thank you for your letter dated 13 March 2014 regarding Petition No. 32.

By way of background I met with representatives from Inglewood Primary School to discuss the school's request that flashing 40km/h school zone signs be installed at the main school as well as the pre-primary site located on Hamer Parade in Inglewood. This followed a car accident at the pre-primary site.

Following this meeting, a site visit was organised with Main Roads WA and the City of Stirling which led to the installation of high visibility caps on the 40km/h speed zone signs in time for the start of the 2014 school year. While these caps are a very welcome measure, the school is very keen to see the installation of flashing 40km/h signs as motorists do not always appear to observe the 40km/h limit during the busy morning and afternoon drop-off and pick-up times.

At the school's request, I wrote to the former Minister for Transport, Hon Troy Buswell MLA, on the matter. In response to my letter, I was informed that he was confident that the school would be given a high priority when the 2014/15 electronic speed zone programme is developed. I am keeping the school updated on this important matter.

I hope this information is of assistance to the Committee.
