Petition No. 124 – Closure of Main Street Jetty to Port Hedland community

Reference is made to the above petition which was tabled by Hon Stephen Dawson MLC in the Legislative Council on 16 August 2016 and referred to the Standing Committee on Environment and Public Affairs (Committee).

I am writing to advise that the last sitting day for the Legislative Council for the current session of Parliament was 22 November 2016, which was followed by prorogation (the termination of the parliamentary session) on 30 January 2017 prior to the State election, scheduled for 11 March 2017.

Prorogation terminates the business of Parliament, including all petitions currently before the Committee. The petition has therefore lapsed. If a petitioner or petitioners want the Committee to continue its consideration of a petition that has lapsed due to prorogation, the petition must be tabled again in the new Parliament next year with at least one signature.
