1. Meeting of Assembly

The Assembly met at 9.00 am pursuant to adjournment.

3. Joint Standing Committee on the Corruption and Crime Commission – Extension of Reporting Date

The Minister for Child Protection on her recent visit to the Dampier Peninsula to hear about the Woommboorny Amboon Angarriya Partnership Initiative project.

The Minister for Science on the Carnarvon Trackers and the Carnarvon Space and Technology Museum.
