Question: Mr. R.S. Love asked when we will see an update of the payment system for off-road vehicles from the current paper-based system.

Answer: New payment options will be available following the passage of legislative amendments to provide for flexible payments.

The Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries has advised the Department of Transport that it anticipates the required amendments will be passed in 2024.

The Department of Transport is working with the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries to define the requirements for a flexible payment system to meet the needs of off-road vehicle owners to ensure that new payment options are available as soon as possible following legislative amendments.


Please provide the proposed implementation timeline of resources online.

Answer:

Resources Online Release 1 (Resources Online Portal, Programmes of Work and Eligible Mining Activity trial) is planned to be implemented in September 2024.

Release 2 (Eligible Mining Activities, Mining Development and Closure Proposals and Mine Closure Plans) is planned for December 2024 to January 2025 dependent on industry representatives availability to participate in user testing.

Release 3 (Environment Plans and Oil Spill Contingency Plans) and Release 4 (Native Vegetation Clearing Permits) are planned for mid to late 2025.
