

## **Transport Ministers of Western Australia**

In the Wise Labor Government of 1945, the Railways Ministry expanded to include Transport and then the two portfolios amalgamated in Sir Charles Court's Liberal Government, from 1974 to 1982. In 1993, during Richard Court's Liberal Government, the State Rail Freight service was sold. The public railway service Westrail and Metrobus remained the responsibility of the Department of Transport. In Geoff Gallop's Labor Government, 2001 the Transport portfolio was absorbed into the Department of Planning and Infrastructure under Hon Alannah MacTiernan's portfolio. In 2008, the Barnett Liberal Government re-established a Minister responsible for Transport.
