INTRODUCTION

This paper contains a summary of the 1996 Western Australian election. It contains details of voting for all Legislative Assembly districts, as well as summaries of voting for the Legislative Council. Details of the 1994 electoral redistribution are also included to assist in understanding the results.

For each Legislative Assembly electorate, full detail of primary and two-candidate preferred votes are provided. Where appropriate, a two-party preferred count is also provided. (See note below). The format for the results are summarized below.

First Count: The votes shown for each candidate are the total primary votes received. Percentage votes are calculated as a percentage of the formal vote for each electorate. Swing is calculated by subtracting the percentage vote received by a party at the previous election (adjusted for the new electoral boundaries) from the percentage received at the current election. Where the parties contesting the district differ from the previous election, 'ghost' candidates (indicated by "...") have been included representing candidates not contesting the current election. As a result, all primary swings add to zero, subject to rounding errors.

Final Count: Represents the two-candidate preferred count after the final distribution of preferences in an electorate. All votes which did not indicate a preference to the two remaining candidates are included in the total listed as Exhausted. Two-candidate preferred percentages are calculated by dividing the two-candidate preferred vote by the votes remaining in the count, that is the formal votes minus the total exhausted votes. Two-candidate preferred swings are shown compared to the adjusted previous election results. Where the party composition of the final two candidates differ from the previous election (eg Alfred Cove), a ghost candidate appears, and three swing figures are shown. A two-party preferred count is also provided in these cases.

Two-Candidate versus Two-Party Preferred results

After the full distribution of preferences in each electorate, the final count is a two-candidate preferred count between the final two candidates. In most electorates, this count is the same as the two-party preferred count between the final candidates of the Labor Party and the Liberal-National Party Coalition. However, this was not the case in eight electorates at the 1996 election. The origin of the two-party preferred count in these electorates is set out below.

Alfred Cove: The two-candidate preferred count was between the Liberal Party and Independent Penny Hearne. The WA Electoral Commission performed a two-party preferred count between the Labor and Liberal parties.

Carine: The two-candidate preferred count was between the Liberal Party and Independent Peter Kyle. The WA Electoral Commission performed a two-party preferred count between the Labor and Liberal parties.

Churchlands: There was no Liberal candidate, so the two-party preferred count has been calculated using the vote for Independent Elizabeth Constable to represent the Liberal two-party preferred vote.

Kimberley: There was no Labor candidate, so the two-party preferred count has been calculated using the vote for Independent Ernie Bridge to represent the Labor two-party preferred vote.

Peel: During the campaign, the Liberal Party candidate was disendorsed, and on election day, the Liberal Party distributed a how-to-vote card recommending a vote for Independent William Hall. His two-candidate vote has been used as the Liberal two-party preferred vote.

Roe: The two-candidate preferred count was between the National Party and Independent Lance Shearer. The WA Electoral Commission performed a two-party preferred count between the Labor and National parties.

South Perth: The two-candidate preferred count was between the Liberal Party and Independent Phillip Pandal. The WA Electoral Commission estimated a two-party preferred count between the Labor Party and Phillip Pandal to represent the Liberal Party.

Vasse: The two-candidate preferred count was between the Liberal Party and National Party. The WA Electoral Commission performed a two-party preferred count between the Labor and Liberal parties.

By-Elections

In re-calculating redistributions, all estimates are based upon results of the previous election. By-election results have been ignored. Details of by-elections conducted between 1993 and 1996 are provided on page 28.

On 10 September 1994, the Liberal Party gained the seat of Helena from the Labor Party at a by-election. However, the seat was abolished in the redistribution, absorbed for the most part into the new seat of Midland, with a safer Labor majority.

Disclaimer

All redistribution calculations have been performed by the author, by transferring booths to conform with the new electoral boundaries. All results for the 1996 election are based on the published results of the WA Electoral Commission. However, responsibility for all calculations and omissions is taken by the author.

SUMMARY OF 1994 REDISTRIBUTION

The following notes summarize the status of the 57 electorates drawn by the 1994 Electoral Distribution Commission. All estimates are based on re-allocating booth results from the 1993 election to the new electorates. By-elections have been ignored in the analysis.

REGIONAL SUMMARIES

The following tables summarise the election result for different regions of the state.
