- (a) what is the minimum amount of time, in years, it would take for groundwater to flow from Yulleroo 3 and Yulleroo 4 fracking wells to Lake Eda on the Roebuck Plains as estimated by the Department of Water;
- (b) what is the minimum amount of time, in years, it would take for groundwater to flow from Yulleroo 3 and Yulleroo 4 fracking wells to Roebuck Bay as estimated by the Department of Water;
- (c) what data does the Department of Water base these estimates on;
- (d) will the Minister table the data which the Department of Water relies on for these estimates; and
- (e) if no to (d), why not?
